**Subject:** Cyber-attack impacting Anthem Inc.

We want to let you know that we have just become aware that Anthem, Inc., the parent company of our health insurance provider, is the victim of a highly sophisticated cyber-attack. Anthem has informed us that its member data was accessed. We are working closely with Anthem to better understand the impact on our members.

Here is what we do know:

- Once Anthem determined it was the victim of a cyber-attack, it immediately notified federal law enforcement officials and shared the indicators of compromise with the HINTRUST C3 (Cyber Threat Intelligence and Incident Coordination Center).
- Anthem's Information Security has worked to eliminate any further vulnerability and continues to secure all of its data.
- Anthem immediately began a forensic IT investigation to determine the number of impacted consumers. Their investigation is ongoing.
- The information accessed may include member names, health ID numbers, Social Security numbers, dates of birth, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses, employment information and/or income data.
- Anthem is actively working to determine which members' Social Security numbers were accessed.
- Anthem's investigation to date shows that no credit card or confidential health information was accessed.
- Anthem has advised us there is no indication at this time that any of our member's personal information has been misused.
- Anthem will enroll all impacted members in identity repair services and provide information on how to enroll in free credit monitoring.

**It is important at this time that each individual be proactive and we strongly suggest that you place a credit fraud alert with a credit reporting agency such as Experian ([www.experian.com](http://www.experian.com)).**

We are continuing to work closely with Anthem to better understand the cyber-attack and the impact on our employees. Anthem has created a website [www.anthemfacts.com](http://www.anthemfacts.com), and a hotline, 1-877-263-7995, for its members to call for more information, and has shared the attached Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) that further explains the cyber-attack.

We will continue to keep you updated on Anthem's ongoing investigation.
