## **STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE**

In connection with the use of an automobile, driving a car is a privilege granted by the State of New Hampshire as long as one drives in a safe and sane manner. Careless driving around the school parking area and driveways is something more than an offense against school regulations. Careless driving is subject to police action and anyone guilty of such careless driving will be reported promptly to the police.

Improper use of a motor vehicle on school grounds can result in suspension from school. Driving a motor vehicle from school grounds during the school day without authorization will be considered improper use of a motor vehicle and will be considered grounds for suspension.

Parking at the school is a privilege granted by the school and the privilege will be withdrawn if it is abused. Parking regulations shall be established by the Principal.

Prior to driving or parking on school grounds, students will be required to register motor vehicles in the main office and will be required to have a permit.

Unregistered vehicles, including mini bikes, trail bikes, and snow machines are not allowed anywhere on school property, including parking lots.
