

# SCHOOL BOARD GOALS

## 2011-2012

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The MISSION of the Timberlane Regional School District is to engage all students in challenging and relevant learning opportunities, emphasizing high aspirations and personal growth.

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- 1 Provide the best possible education for our students, while striving to make that education as economical as possible to protect the interests of our taxpayers. Improvement strategies will be guided by "Strategic Planning," "New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC)," other program evaluations, data collection and best practices research.
- 2 Develop opportunities for all students to succeed and achieve their potential through the support of enrichment, differentiated instructional strategies, vocational training, and the continued development of a "3 Tiered Response To Instruction" student support model. Implement alternative educational strategies to meet the needs of all students.
- 3 Insure a continuous improvement and maintenance of all district facilities with an emphasis on energy savings, efficiency and improving the teaching and learning capacity and programming.
- 4 Update the Capital Improvement Plan with emphasis on developing a "bond ready" plan for the construction of a new high school and on renovating the existing high school into a middle school. This plan shall include detailed concept drawings based on current and future educational specifications. Cost estimates shall be developed with calculations of bond cost and impact on annual budgets, keeping in mind current state moratorium on building aid.
- 5 Work to develop a "culture of safety" in which all members of the Timberlane community are invested in and responsible for safety, achieved through policy and procedure review, ongoing training, incident reporting / investigation, conducting practice drills, as well as working closely with our risk management company and community public safety partners, to ensure we have safe facilities, equipment, and work practices.
- 6 Work with the superintendent to provide the district's position on funding and other legislative issues to key representatives and state officials in Concord.
- 7 Support the improvement of standardized tests scores and to make sure all schools in the district are approved and accredited.
- 8 Provide board training for new and recently elected members with ongoing evaluations of committees.
